We'll view some of the elegant houses and hear about the lives of those in the affluent part of town. After crossing the Glomma River, we'll learn about the working class of Røros and get a glimpse into how they lived. You'll meander of the Slagghaugene, the waste from the copper mine, and visit the Smelthytta and Røros Museum, before rounding off the walk near the beautiful Røros Church.
